The Total Cost of the project was Rs. 60 Lacs & was inaugurated on 7th Sept, 2011. Chief Guest was Rtn.Dr. P. V. Ravi- District Governor rotary dt 3202. Guest of owner Rtn. Major Donor PDG K. Kuriachan- Rotary dt. 3201.

This project was started in the year 2009-2010 and has been completed in September 2011.

Medical Camp at Muncipal School -27th November

This Medical camp was carried on 27th November, 2011 at A- ward Municipal Dispensary at Colaba Market & was well attended by our Rotarians & Anns.

The Medicines were donated by Wockhardt Hospital & Alkem Laboratories.

This camp was eye Camp as well as General Medical Camp. The Doctors from our Club who attended to the patients were Dr. B. T. Shah/ Dr. Ashiq Patel/ Dr. Sujata Dalvi.

Eye Checkups were conducted by Dr. B.T. Shah and two Optometrists. Free medicines were given to patients.

5 patients were selected for free cataract surgery and were referred to Bachooali Hospital, Parel, for pre-operative investigations.

Patients with Medical /Gynecological problems were advised by Dr. Ashiq Patel and Dr. Sujata Dalvi and given free medications.

The Glasses were given at a token charge of Rs. 10/-. Those, deserving patients who did not have Rs. 10/- were issued glasses free of Cost.

Total 82 patients were attended to.
